★ BIKE SKILLS TRAINING & EDUCATION

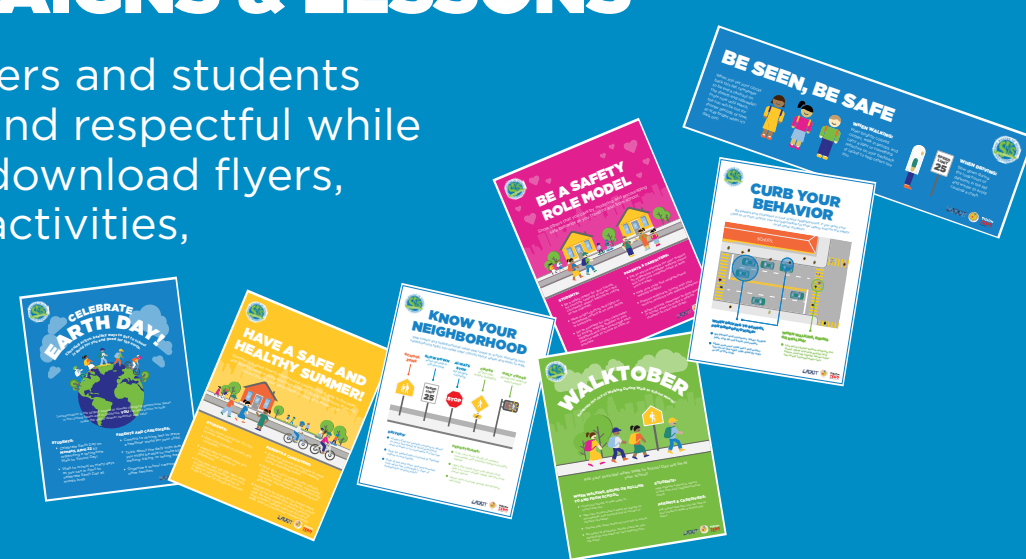
★ TRAFFIC SAFETY CITY

CELEBRATE WALKING & BICYCLING! Annual Events

- ★ WALK TO SCHOOL DAY & BIKE TO SCHOOL DAY (Early October) (Mid-May)

Schools communities walk and bike together to school to reinforce personal and traffic safety on routes to school. To request planning/logistics support and give-aways, register at www.saferoutes.lacity.org



★ STUDENT TRAVEL TALLY PROJECT

Teachers or staff administer an easy hand-raising survey to capture how students travel to/from school. SRTS provides survey instructions and forms, and prepares customized Tally Reports for each school. To request, contact SRTS.



INCREASE SCHOOL ZONE SAFETY

Drop Off/Pick Up Area Programs

★ SCHOOL SAFETY VALET

Launch a Valet to support more orderly traffic and increase safety for people walking to school. Traffic cones channel drivers into a drop off/pick up queue, and staff assist students to exit the car. Contact your LAUSD OEHS Safety Officer for Valet kit and training.

★ STUDENT SAFETY PATROLS

As student safety leaders, Patrols promote a culture of traffic safety, sharing traffic safety rules with peers, and building awareness about traffic safety with parents/caregivers. To learn more, contact SRTS.
